

Defensive Driving Skills Package

(A student must have a minimum of 30 hours of on-road experience including night driving and highway driving.)

- **Parent Class – Mandatory if student is testing with DrivingMBA (recommended for all parents or guardians)**
(3 hours – ideally scheduled early on in the program)
Designed for the parents or guardian of the student to assist them in the practice phase of the driver training process. The class includes information regarding teenage driving and instruction from a DrivingMBA instructor who introduces what to do when practicing with your student.

On-Road Driving Instruction

- **On-Road Driving Lessons**
(1:1 instruction scheduled in 2-hour lessons – packages available with 6, 8 or 10 hours of instruction)
Private instruction designed to continue to build fundamental skills around **core objectives listed above**. Student is exposed to a multitude of driving situations such as city and freeway driving and more. During the last 2-hour lesson the student has a brief warm-up and is evaluated. *If a student is registered for a program including 10 hours of on-road instruction, the student is evaluated. If the student passes DrivingMBA's evaluation, they are issued a waiver that will waive the test at the MVD.*



Defensive Driver Training

- **Defensive Driving Orientation**
(2 hours - class is scheduled before Defensive Driving Simulation lessons)
This class introduces the defensive driving principles the student will experience on the simulator including hazard recognition, vehicle handling, space management, and speed management. For example, students will learn in the orientation what to do if they get a tire blow out; then the student will experience a tire blow-out in the simulation lab.
- **Defensive Driving Skills Simulation Lab**
(6 hours – 1:1 instruction scheduled in three 2-hour lessons – equivalent to 9 classroom hours. Scheduled after student is comfortable with basic skills, driving on the freeway, and driving at night). The program is designed to develop skills in hazard recognition, vehicle handling, space and speed management and further develop observation, planning and decision making skills. This is done through 40 different scenarios allowing students to



experience a multitude of risky situations and the ability to learn from their mistakes. Students are assessed before they begin the program utilizing a profiler assessment to determine areas of weakness and again at the end of the program to measure improvement.

Optional Courses:

- **Car Maintenance Class**

(1.5 hours – class is held at a maintenance shop either at Community Tire or Tire Pros. The class is scheduled once a month in Phoenix and 4 times a year in Chandler. A student can schedule it at any time.) Designed to cover tire maintenance, engine fluids, using jumper cables, signs of engine distress and much more. Students also learn the responsibility of maintaining their vehicle.
